INSTRUCTION NO.01/2022 DATED 22.07.2022

Attentions of all stakeholders are invited towards the Airports authority of India (Lost Property) Regulations, 2003 which stipulates that all the lost / found goods and mis handled baggage landed at / or found within the premises of CCSI Airport, Lucknow, are to be handed over to Customs Authorities by M/s ALIAL / concerned Airlines.

In the light of above, the following instructions should be adhered to by all concerned:-

1. M/s ALIAL / Concerned Airlines should hand over all lost / found and mis-handled items inclusive of (i) foreign and Indian Currency (ii) gold in any form (iii) restricted and prohibited items and any other valuable / dutiable goods which remain unclaimed landed at or found within the premises of CCSI Airport, Lucknow, to the Customs Authorities. The baggage not meant for clearance / exit at CCSI airport, Lucknow, are not covered by these instructions and shall not be accepted by Lucknow Airport Customs Officers.
2. M/s ALIAL / Concerned Airlines should deposit any arms, ammunition and explosives landed at or found within the premises of CCSI, Airport, Lucknow, with the CISF / Police Authorities.

3. M/s ALIAL / Concerned Airlines should hand over any Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substance (NDPS items), gold in any form and precious stones landed at or found within the premises of CCSI Airport, Lucknow, immediately to the Customs Authorities.
4. Barring the goods mentions at serial no.3, all the other assorted valuable / dutiable, lost / found or mis-handled goods found by M/s ALIAL / concerned Airlines may be kept in their custody for a reasonable period of three months. Thereafter, the unclaimed goods should be handed over to the Customs Authorities, invariable on 2nd and 16th day of every month.
5. All the other lost / found or mis-handled goods in possession of M/s ALIAL / Concerned Airlines require to be intimated to the Deputy Commissioner/ Assistant Commissioner in-charge of Airport before their disposal by of M/s ALIAL / Concerned Airlines in accordance with Regulation 6 and 7 of referred Regulations, so as to confirm that the subject goods are not in violation of any provisions of Customs act, 1962 or under any law in force and/or there is no Customs duty incidence on them.
6. The handing over and taking over of the valuable / dutiable goods should be under an inventory prepared by M/s ALIAL, with detailed description like type of baggage, colour and size, weight, marks / numbers if any, or any other identification particulars.
7. Valuable items like gold in any form, precious stones, currency and any other such valuable items, should be sealed in presence of M/s ALIAL or any other body, who shall sign the sealed packet alongwith the Customs officials.
8. Once the handed over goods are sealed, the Customs officers shall take further action as per the extant laws and instructions.

M/s ALIAL / Concerned Airlines shall be held accountable for any lapse / deviation noticed, in violation of this Instruction. They should ensure that these Instructions alongside various baggage handling procedures, Public Notices, Orders issued by the Customs Authorities on baggage handling, should be disseminated among the persons involved.

All the concerned should follow these instructions scrupulously. Any deviation may invite penal proceedings.
